Define the Technology Ministry

Vision - communicate an embrace-able vision.
e.g. "A connected congregation, interacting with their Home-bounds through technology with the fundamentals of compassion and theology."

Mission - e.g. "achieve all necessary actions which will define successfully implementing a ministry to address remotes in a more interactive way."

Mission Objectives - e.g. "Over the next 30 days we shall connect our 10 home-bounds to the church using Lightcast technology and allow them to listen to the 10:30 services. If they so choose to have visitors, lay visitors will be by their sides periodically. We will re-connect our Home-bounds and make all mindful that if anyone is important in the church, all are."

Purpose - e.g. "lay persons and Home-Bounds may both benefit from new way for caring-discipleship, community - fellowship, connection - worship by using the lay installed technology and its ability to re-connect those who are missing."

Motive - e.g. "We care for the sick because God cares for them. This is not to be passive, proactive as God did for us with Jesus."

Problem Statement - e.g. "We have many Home-bounds who miss out on church activities (worship, fellowship, prayer) for many different reasons, from chronic and temporary illnesses to caregivers and military leaves."

Concept - e.g. "Let's bring our all types of Home-bounds back into the fold."

START HERE and BUILD UP

1. Define the **Concept**
2. Define the **Problem Statement** this is where most failure occurs - define your audience or participants, in this case it may be Home-bounds of all types, e.g. chronic home-bounds, pregnant mothers, caregivers to ill, personnel on military leave, nursing home or hospital patients, identify how they are not able to connect to the church anymore.
3. Define **Motive** - you may want to use scripture here, e.g. We care for the sick because God cares for them. This is not to be passive, proactive as God did for us with Jesus.
4. Define **the needs** and look at **the purpose** - e.g. lay persons and Home-bounds may both benefit from new way for caring-discipleship, community - fellowship, connection - worship by using the lay installed technology and its ability to re-connect those who are missing.
5. Develop **Mission** - how do we get from here to there, a project chain of command
6. Develop **Mission Objectives** - specific, measurable, attainable, realistic, time and cost budgeted, e.g. over the next 30 days we shall connect our 10 home-bounds to the church using Lightcast technology and allow them to listen to the 10:30 services with lay visitors by their side for the first 2 weekends, if they so choose. This can be paid for by an adopt-a-homebound class campaign in which 10 classes will be responsible for one homebound. The approx. cost will be \$.70 per week per classroom attendee, or a dime a day.
7. Develop **Vision Statement** - what is the ultimate destination we are striving for, paint a visual description.
